

What are the working hours on site?

Construction work will take place between the hours of 07:00 and 19:00 Monday to Saturday and at no time on Sundays or bank holidays. This is to ensure that noise disturbance to immediate neighbours is limited.

During different phases of the project there may be some variation to working hours, but daily start and finish times will fall within the limitations set out above.

How long is the construction activity expected to take?

The project is expected take up to 3 years to complete but the majority of the construction activity will take place between the months of March and October due to weather constraints.

Are the agreed working hours likely to change?

If an unexpected need arises for any work to be conducted outside of the agreed hours, we will need to provide a detailed scheme and this would have to be agreed in writing by Dorset Council. Notice would also be given to immediate neighbours.

When will the offices be occupied?

Kier expect to complete work on the site compound including the welfare facilities and offices by the start of June. From this point, there will be a team presence on site year round until completion of the project.

Can I visit the Site Office?

We would like to welcome visitors at the site office. To ensure there is somebody available who can help you with your enquiries and to help maintain safety we are planning to establish some public 'office hours'. It is envisaged that this will be a set time each week. Office Hours will be advertised on the Dorset Coast Forum Website in due course. How will disturbance to local businesses be managed?

During peak holiday season there will be restrictions in place to ensure noise is kept to a minimum near the boundary with Ridge Farm Camping and Caravan site. During July and August, plant machinery or power tools will only be used in this area between the hours of 08:00-18:00 Monday to Friday and 08:00 -13:00 on Saturdays and at no time on Sundays or Public or Bank Holidays.
