

The Moors at Arne Project

Notice of start of works and increased HGV traffic

6 July 2023

The main 2023 programme of works is expected to commence during the week of 10 July 2023.

Over the next three to four weeks we will be constructing the site compound area and access roads within the site. In order to bring in the necessary materials, there will be an increased volume of Heavy Goods Vehicle (HGV) traffic along Arne Road and New Road. We apologise in advance for any disruption caused during this time.

During this period we are expecting an average of three HGV deliveries per hour but at most there could be up to six.

Following this initial peak, there will be a steady number of HGVs passing along the route until the end of October when we will demobilise until March 2024. The full scheme is expected to be completed by autumn 2025.

All HGV drivers have been briefed and instructed to follow the diversion route and temporary 20mph speed limit and adhere to the relevant sections of our Construction Traffic Management Plan which can be viewed on the Dorset Coast Forum website:

A Traffic Marshall will be stationed at the junction of New Road and Arne Road during the busier periods to co-ordinate HGV traffic with the site team via radio.
